<b>Encoding</b>	UTF-8
<b>Separator</b>	tab
<b>String qualifier</b>	double quotes "
<b>New line format</b>	tab

### (REQUIRED UNLESS MARKED OPTIONAL)

<b>Date</b>	string, ranking date, must be YYYY-MM-DD
<b>Project</b>	string, name of the project in STAT
<b>Site</b>	string, name of the site in STAT
<b>Keyword</b>	string, lowercase, not allowed to contain "site:" or "inurl:"
<b>Market</b>	string, e.g. US-en
<b>Location</b>	string (optional)
<b>Device</b>	string, can be "desktop" or "smartphone"
<b>Engine</b>	string "google"
<b>Rank</b>	integer, leave blank to indicate non-ranking
<b>Base_Rank</b>	integer, only applies to Google (optional)
<b>URL</b>	string, lowercase (optional)
<b>Tags</b>	string, lowercase, comma-separated list of tags (optional)
<b>CSV, TSV, JSON</b>	<description?>
